ANNEXURE-III
KARUNYA PLUS WEEKLY LOTTERY
TERMS AND CONDITION
(KN 360th Lottery onwards)

(Vide Order No.SLTY/ 172(4)/2021/-S1 Dated : - 02 .02.2021)

1. Tickets will be printed in **twelve** series.
2. The maximum retail price of one ticket will be **Rs.40/-**(Face value 31.25+28% GST) only. One book of tickets will contain twenty five tickets.
3. The first , second and third prizes will be drawn in full coming under the assured portion of prizes. The remaining prizes will be under variable portion depending upon the sale of tickets.
4. The consolation prizes of Rs.8000/- each will be awarded to the tickets in other **eleven** series, having the same number of 1st prize winning number.
5. The fourth prize will be determined by drawing the last four digits **eighteen** times and extended to all sold tickets in all series.
6. The fifth prize will be determined by drawing the last four digits **thirty four** times and extended to all sold tickets in all series.
7. The sixth prize will be determined by drawing the last four digits **eighty** times and extended to all sold tickets in all series.
8. The seventh prize will be determined by drawing the last four digits **one hundred and twenty six** times and extended to all sold tickets in all series.
9. If any prize numbers in any category is repeated the same will be cancelled and redrawn
10. An amount equal to 12% of prize money will be deducted from 1st , 2nd and 3rd prizes and given as agents commission on prize to the agents concerned . An amount equivalent to 12% of the prize money on 4th to 6th prizes and consolation prize and also an amount equivalent to 20% of the prize money on 7th prize will be given to the agents concerned as agents commission on prize from Government fund.

11. (i) Registered agents will get the tickets at the following discounted rates, for the entire purchase irrespective of the district of purchase.

(a) Up to 2000 tickets	-	76% of face value
(b) 2001 to 8400 tickets	-	75.25% of face value
(c) Above 8400 tickets	-	74.5% of the face value

(ii) The highest eligible discounted rate will be allowed for the entire tickets purchased by an agency. The above mentioned discounted rate will be allowed based on the total purchase of tickets from the different District Lottery Offices/Lottery sub offices. The dues or excess amount collected, if any, will be adjusted in future claims or by exchange of tickets of the next lottery, as the case may be, from the office of registration/the corresponding lottery sub offices.

12. The prize winners shall prefer their claims within 30 days from the date of draw. First and second winning ticket should be surrendered to the Director of State Lotteries in person or by insured registered post or through Nationalised/ Scheduled Banks/ State or District Co-operative Banks supported with necessary documents.
13. The prizes of Rs.1,00,000/- and below may be claimed from the District Lottery Offices /Lottery sub offices. The prize winners of outside state of Kerala should present their prize claim of Rs.1,00,000/- and above before the Director of State Lotteries. The prize winners should record their name and signature in the space provided on the reverse side of the ticket. Payment of prize money will be made only after ascertaining the genuineness of the tickets with counterfoils or by any other method as decided by the Director from time to time.
14. Agents are allowed to collect prize tickets with prize money of Rs.5000/- and below and pay the prize money to the prize winners themselves and thereafter claim prize money on behalf of prize winners by exchange of tickets. The agents should clearly state whether the prize tickets are collected and prize money already paid to the prize winners by them, while presenting the same for payment.
15. Claims on mutilated or tampered tickets will be rejected outright. One ticket can win only the highest prize awarded on it. Income Tax and Surcharge etc. if any, will be deducted at source from the prize money as laid down in the Finance Act (Central).
16. Legal jurisdiction of this Lottery will be at Thiruvananthapuram.

S.R.O .No...../2021. - In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-rule (3) of Rule 3 of the Lotteries (Regulation) Rules, 2010, issued by the Government of India under sub-section (1) of section 11 of the Lotteries (Regulation) Act, 1998 (Central Act 17 of 1998), and in supersession of the notification issued under G.O.(P) No. 12/2020/TAXES dated 1st February, 2020 and published as S.R.O. No. 89/2020 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No.344 dated 1st February, 2020 the Government of Kerala hereby notify the following information in respect of the *Karunya Plus Weekly Lottery* to be organized by the Government of Kerala, namely:-

- (a) Name of the lottery or lottery scheme : Karunya Plus Weekly Lottery
- (b) Maximum Retail Price of the lottery ticket : ₹40/- (Rupees Forty only)
(Face Value ₹31.25+28% GST)
- (c) Total number of tickets printed in case of paper lottery : 1 crore and 8 lakh (One crore and eight lakh only)
- (d) Gross value of the tickets printed : ₹33,75,00,000/-
(Thirty three crore seventy five lakhs only)
- (e) Name or names of the distributors or selling agents with their addresses and contact information : Kerala State Lottery Agents and Sellers' Welfare Fund Board.

- (f) Prize structure : Tickets are issued in twelve series with the prize structure stated in the Table given below:

- (g) Amount offered as prize money : ₹20,10,16,000 /-
(Rupees Twenty crore ten lakh and sixteen thousand only)
- (h) Periodicity of the draw : Every Thursday (Except National Holidays)
- (i) Place where the draw shall be conducted : Thiruvananthapuram or any other places in the State

(j) The procedure for drawing the prize winning tickets or prize winners : The Government appoints a panel of judges and the draws are conducted under the supervision of the panel. The panel selects one among them as Chairman/Chairperson. The draw is conducted by operating the draw machine based on random technology or in the case of contingency, using drums and coins, as the case may be.

The draw shall be commenced only after convincing the panel of judges and spectators about the *modus operandi* of the draw machine. All the spectators shall be convinced that all digits/alphabet representing ticket number and series respectively are stuck on the wheel fixed on the shaft by manually rotating it. A digital photograph will be taken along with the recording of the draw process using a digital camera or a suitable device. The draw machine will be operated by pressing the switch. The motor will be operated for five seconds for drawing every single prize number/numbers. The prize winning ticket is taken after pressing the switch by the members of the panel of Judges or the public. Then the disk engraved / stuck with series and digits rotates and come to a stand still when a particular number appears on the slots provided for the display of selected prize numbers. All other prizes are also drawn in the similar manner based on the prize structure of the lottery. For selecting the consecutive prize numbers, all other windows except the one which is to be used for selecting a particular prize number / numbers shall be covered by shutters. Prizes shall be drawn either in the ascending or descending order. When a prize number is selected, the officer in charge of declaring the result should announce the number. The personnel deputed from the Department of Lotteries shall then verify whether the drawn number is sold or unsold. If the selected number is unsold the draw procedure of that particular number will be repeated till a new number is exposed in the windows. If any number is found repetitive that number will invariably be cancelled and draw will be repeated. On announcing the prize number the officer in charge of documenting the prize number shall document this in a prize register and Judges will

subsequently verify this by according their signature on it. When the draw is completed the prize register thus prepared will be authenticated by every Judge present at the draw of the Lottery.

In case of any contingency, such as technical error in draw machines or shortage of draw machine are occurred, the method of draw using drums and coins, as described below shall be used:

There shall be seven rotatable drums, which is operated by the staff of the Lotteries Department. The First drum represents the series of lottery, and the rests represent the digits from lakhs to units. Plastic tokens engraved with series, for eg.) PA, PB, PC, PD, PE, PF, PG, PH, PJ, PK, PL,PM shall be deposited in the series drum and similar tokens engraved with the digits 0-9 shall be deposited in the other drums. All the tokens shall be concealed in plastic purses which can be opened with hand. Before the beginning of the draw, the Judges shall inspect the empty drums, purses and the tokens. The tokens shall then be thrust into the plastic purses and deposited into the drums one by one . Then all the drums shall simultaneously be rotated so that the tokens in plastic purses may get shuffled within the drums. The drums shall be operated by persons duly authorised by the Director of State Lotteries. Thereafter, the Chairman shall open the drums after removing the lid and take one token from the purse and show it to the audience. It shall be recorded in the display board as well as in the register kept by the Lotteries Department which shall be attested by the panel of Judges.

Accordingly a series with six digit numbers shall be formed and announced as prize winning number. Based on the prize structure of the lottery the remaining other prizes are also drawn in the similar manner.

Explanatory Note

(This does not form part of the notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

As per sub-rule (3) of Rule 3 of the Lotteries (Regulation) Rules ,2010 issued by the Government of India as G.S.R. 278 (E) dated 1st April, 2010 published in Part II , Section 3(i) of the Gazette of India Extraordinary dated the 1st day of April, 2010 , the lottery organizing State shall announce in advance by way of a notification in its Official Gazette, the information , the name of lottery, price of lottery ticket, total number of tickets printed etc. as prescribed in the said Rule The Government of Kerala have decided to announce the above information , as modified, in respect of the *Karunya Plus Weekly Lottery* and to issue notification for the purpose by superseding earlier notification issued under G.O.(P) No. 12/2020/TAXES dated 1st February, 2020 and published as S.R.O. No. 89/2020 in the Kerala Gazette Extraordinary No.344 dated 1st February, 2020
