In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-rule (3) of rule 3 of the Lotteries (Regulation) Rules, 2010, issued by the Government of India under sub-section (1) of section 11 of the Lotteries (Regulation) Act, 1998 (Central Act 17 of 1998), the Government of Kerala hereby notify the following information, in respect of the X'Mas - New Year Bumper Lottery 2025-26 (BR-107) to be organized by the Government of Kerala, namely:-



- (a) Name of the lottery or lottery scheme : X'Mas - New Year Bumper Lottery 2025-26 (BR-107)
- (b) Price of the lottery ticket : ₹ 400 (Rupees Four Hundred only)
(Ticket Price ₹ 285.72 + 40% Goods and Services Tax)
- (c) Total number of tickets printed in case of paper lottery : 90,00,000 (Ninety lakh)
- (d) Gross value of the tickets printed : ₹2,57,14,80,000/-(Rupees Two hundred and fifty seven crore fourteen lakh and eighty thousand only)
- (e) Name or names of the distributors or selling agents with their addresses and contact information : Kerala State Lottery Agents' and Sellers' Welfare Fund Board,
Head Office, K.S.R.T.C. Bus Terminal Complex, 3rd Floor, Thampanoor, Thiruvananthapuram-695 001.
- (f) Prize structure : Tickets are issued in TEN series (XA, XB, XC, XD, XE, XG, XH, XJ, XK, XL) with the prize structure stated in the table given below

- (g) Amount offered as prize money : ₹93,22,00,000/- (Rupees Ninety three crore twenty two lakh only)
- (h) Periodicity of the draw : Bumper Draw
- (i) Place where the draw shall be conducted : Thiruvananthapuram.
- (j) The procedure for drawing the prize winning tickets or prize winners : The draw shall be conducted in accordance with rule 8 of the Kerala Paper Lotteries Regulation Rules, 2005, at a time specified by the Director and announced in advance. The draw shall be conducted using a mechanical device based on random technology. It shall be supervised by a panel of judges not below three members, including a Chairman. In the event of a contingency where the required quorum of three judges is not met, the Director or an officer authorized by the Director may co-opt suitable individuals from among the audience to fill the required positions.
- Prior to the commencement of the draw the operational procedure of the draw machine shall be explained to the Judges and to the spectators. The draw process may be broad casted live on television channels and/or the official social media platforms of the State Lotteries Department.
- The mechanical device shall be operated by either the panel of judges or members of the general public, as determined by the draw procedure, to select the winning numbers. All other prizes shall be drawn in a similar manner, in accordance with the established prize structure. Prizes may be drawn in either ascending or



descending order. Once a prize number is selected, it shall be publicly announced.

Officials deputed from the Department of State Lotteries shall verify whether the drawn number has been sold or remains unsold. If an unsold number is drawn, the process shall be repeated until a valid number is selected. In the event of a duplicate selection, the repeated number shall be cancelled, and the draw for that prize shall be conducted again.

Upon the announcement of a winning number, the designated officer shall document it in the official prize proforma. The judges shall verify the recorded details and affix their signatures as confirmation. Upon completion of the draw, the finalized prize proforma shall be authenticated by all judges present.

In the case of any unforeseen contingencies, such as technical malfunctions of the draw machines or insufficient availability of draw devices, the alternative method of conducting the draw using drums and coins shall be used.

Explanatory Note

(This does not form part of the notification, but is intended to indicate its general purport.)

As per sub-rule (3) of rule 3 of the Lotteries (Regulation) Rules, 2010 issued by the Government of India as G.S.R. 278 (E) dated 1st April, 2010 and published in Part II, section 3, sub-section (i) of the Gazette of India Extraordinary dated 1st April, 2010, the lottery organizing State shall announce in advance by way of a notification in its Official Gazette, the information such as the name of lottery, price of lottery ticket, total number of tickets printed etc. as prescribed in the above said rule. The Government of Kerala have decided to announce the above information in respect of X'Mas - New Year Bumper Lottery 2025-26 (BR-107) and to issue notification for the purpose.

The notification is intended to achieve the above object.

(Vide Order No.SLTY/4591/2025-S1 Dated :15-11-2025) TICKETS
IN TEN SERIES:- XA,XB,XC,XD,XE,XG,XH,XJ,XK,XL

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Tickets will be printed in **TEN** series.
2. The maximum retail price of one ticket will be **Rs.400/-only**(Ticket prize **285.72+40%GST**). One book of tickets will contain **ten** tickets.
3. **The first to Fifth prizes** will be drawn in full and are coming under the assured portion of prizes. The remaining prizes will be under variable portion depending upon the sale of tickets.
4. The consolation prizes of **Rs.1,00,000/-each** will be awarded to the tickets in other **NINE** series, having the same number of 1st prize winning number.
5. The **sixth prize** will be determined by drawing the last four digits **Twenty Five** times and extended to all sold tickets in all series.
6. The **seventh prize** will be determined by drawing the last four digits **Fifty four** times and extended to all sold tickets in all series.
7. The **eighth prize** will be determined by drawing the last four digits **Ninty** times and extended to all sold tickets in all series.
8. The **Ninth prize** will be determined by drawing the last four digits

Two hundred and Fifty two times and extended to all sold tickets in all series.

9. The **Tenth prize** will be determined by drawing the last four digits **Two hundred and Seventy times** and extended to all sold tickets in all series.
10. If any prize number of any category is repeated the same will be cancelled and redrawn.
11. An amount equivalent to **10%** of prize money on **1st to 5th** and consolation prizes will be deducted from the prize money and paid to the respective agents as agents commission on prize.
12. An amount equivalent to **10%** of the prize money on **6th to 10th** prizes will be given to the agents concerned as agents commission on prize from Government fund.
13. Registered agents will get the tickets at the following discounted rates, for the entire purchase irrespective of the District of Purchase.
 - (a) Up to 1000 tickets-**77.5%** of the Ticket prize
 - (b) Above 1000 tickets-**76.5%** of the Ticket prize
14. The highest eligible discounted rate will be allowed for the entire tickets purchased by an agency. The above mentioned discounted rate will be allowed based on the total purchase of tickets from the different District Lottery Offices and Lottery Sub Offices. The dues or excess amount collected, if any, will be adjusted in future claims or by exchange of tickets of the next lottery, as the case may be, from the office of registration.
15. **X'MAS NEW YEAR BUMPER Incentive for agents based on the sale of XMAS NEW YEAR BUMPER lottery (BR-107) tickets will be given at the following rates after the draw : Rs.1/-each for every ticket.**
16. Special incentive will be allowed to the agents who purchase maximum number of tickets as follows :-
 1. For the **highest** purchaser - Rs.35,000/-
 2. For the **Second** highest purchaser - Rs.20,000/-
 3. For the **Third** highest purchaser - Rs.15,000/-

If two or more agents become eligible for special incentive at any of the above stage for having purchased equal number of tickets, the incentive amount will be equally divided among them, subject to

the minimum of next lower purchaser.

17. Common incentive prize of 1st and 2nd will be awarded to the agents for the highest purchase of and above 1000 tickets in each District, including District Lottery Offices and its corresponding Lottery Sub Offices. If more than one agent purchases the same number of tickets in a district the amount will be divided among them equally subject to the minimum of Common incentive.

i. Common Incentive prize 1st (District Prize 1st)-Rs.3000/-

ii. Common Incentive prize 2nd (District Prize 2nd)-
Rs.1000/-

18. The prize winning tickets should be surrendered within 90 days from the date of draw. The First and Second prize winning tickets should be surrendered to the Director of State Lotteries in person or by insured/registered post or through Nationalised/Scheduled Banks/Kerala Bank/State or District Co-operative Banks supported with necessary documents.

19. Prize of Rs.10,00,000/- and below may be claimed from the District/Sub Lottery Offices. The prize winners of outside state of Kerala should present their prize claim of Rs.1,00,000/- and above before the Director Of State Lotteries. The prize winners should record their name, address and signature in the space provided on the reverse side of the ticket. Payment of prize money will be made only after ascertaining the genuineness of the tickets with counterfoils or by any other method as decided by the Director from time to time.

20. Agents may collect prized tickets up to Rs 5000/- from prize winners after making prize payment and present them before the concerned office within ninety days from the date of draw for reimbursement of the prize money paid to each winner.

21. Claims on mutilated or tampered tickets will be rejected outright. One ticket can win only the highest prize awarded on it. Income Tax and Surcharge etc. if any, will be deducted at source from the prize money as laid down in the Finance Act (Central).

22. Legal jurisdiction of this Lottery will be at Thiruvananthapuram.
